

# SPOTLIGHT ON: ICONS!

We've all seen them – the **icons** on the side of our names in Family Search when we're looking at our Family Tree in Landscape view. But what do they mean?



You're in luck if you see this icon. It means that Family search has some **record hints** for you!



This icon tells you that there is a **data problem**. It can be as simple as a formatting issue, or as confusing as someone's being born after their parents' deaths. Fix these = better search results



This is the **research suggestions** icon. Look to see the suggestion (perhaps something is missing).

Members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints will see these icons as well, indicating the **status** of the ordinance work for their ancestors.
