- ✓ Do **descendancy** research, starting five generations back

- ✓ Write the family story in book form, using a service like Amazon provides to make it a free ebook available to family
- ✓ Start a blog or website about a branch of particular interest
- ✓ **Connect** with others working on the line

- ✓ Index records that may have more information
- ✓ Organize a **family reunion**
- ✓ Help someone else with their tree
- ✓ Participate in FindaGrave
- ✓ Become a professional genealogist (find out more at apgen.org)
- ✓ Read *Advanced Genealogy Research Techniques* by George Morgan & Drew Smith & burst through your brick walls
- ✓ **Volunteer** your time at your Family History Center to share your expertise with others
- ✓ Choose an ancestor and write his or her biography or write a series of short biographies for a group of ancestors
